




Disobedience led to the removal of Adam & Eve from the Garden of Eden and God's presence. How your sin impact your personal relationship with God?

## **Journey of Faith**


We must develop faith along this journey with God. It is required of us & must be tested & seen in action.

Think about your journey this year. On the road signs, write an event or trial that tested your faith & caused you to grow closer to God this year on your faith journey.




Think about the characteristics listed below. Highlight/underline those that are characteristic of someone demonstrating faith in God.
